Enrolment of two pupils into second and third class accepted.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Balance for end of December 2019 presented to the board.

<u>Principal's Report</u>:

Pupils/ Staffing

Enrolment: 220 pupils minus one family of three children plus two new pupils into 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} now means 219 on roll.

Enrolment week is taking place during the Week of 3rd February 2020.

Attendance: overall is good, a lot of sickness before Christmas especially in Junior Classes.

Staff attendance: Special Needs Assistant out for 3 months, has now returned. Parental Leave / Paternity Leave: had sub cover. Maternity leave: Sub cover was immediately in place (same sub, even though leave commenced two weeks earlier than expected). We have been extremely lucky in getting substitute teachers in to cover any staff absences. There is a huge shortage of substitute teachers. We had no retired teachers in subbing.

<u>Curriculum</u>: All staff attended Primary Language Curriculum Training Day in December . Principal also attended a training day for principals in helping to lead the changes going forward with the new PLC. We have half day closures to take as webinairs become available this year.

<u>Primary Language Curriculum</u>: Staff continue to engage in and examine the new Curriculum.

Science: PDST (Professional Development Service for Teachers) School support booked for this Term in the area of Science.

<u>English Scheme</u>: Reps from the English schemes are booked in Jan/ Feb to give presentations on the new schemes available. Staff will look at all schemes and decide on what suits the needs of our school the best

<u>Posts of Responsibilities</u>: 4 new I Pads have been purchased, website is updated by all class teachers on a monthly basis, Ms Winters will be demonstrating google drive and all plans will be placed on this drive. All classes have W FI Extenders now.

School Choir: performed at the 150 Year celebration of the Church.

Science: Parents Association paid for 1000 euro worth of Science equipment: Mrs Davis oversaw the selecting and purchasing of this equipment.

Student Council: election took place before Christmas: Students presented their "campaigns" at Assembly and between classes. Election was held and 8 students were elected. 2 pupils from each class 3^{rd} - 6^{th} .

Parent Teacher Meetings: ran very smoothly and were well attended by all.

Great work done by Parent's Association in fundraising before Christmas with the Christmas raffle, (fantastic prizes and sponsorship), Christmas Jumper day and Santa's visit to the school. 2,202 was raised with raffle and 245 for Jumper day.
